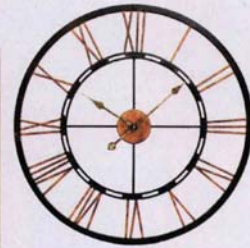


Be inspired by Kate's study area

Modern Country Classic Cottage windows

Choose replacement windows that are a close match to the originals. Cottage-style windows are divided into individual panes but, due to modern energy regulations for double glazing, they will require

thicker bars to hold each pane than the originals. To give a similar look, spacer bars are fitted within the large panes of a sealed unit and sometimes bars or leading are added to the inside and outside as well.
